The department of Translation, Interpreting and Communication of Ghent University is organizing the specialized postgraduate programme Computer-Assisted Language Mediation (CALM).

By offering this postgraduate programme we intend to meet the industry's growing demand for training courses in advanced translation and language technology. We aim at students who want are interested in a career in the language, translation and communication industry and who wish to develop their technological competencies. CALM is also intended for language professionals who wish to enhance their technological and digital skills.

The programme offers a wide range of assets:

- CALM is an advanced and high-quality professional training programme that focuses on the technological skills and tools.
- CALM is an international programme; all courses are taught in English.
- CALM is designed for master's degree holders.
- CALM complements language and communication degrees such as Masters in Translation, Interpreting, Multilingual Communication, Language and Literature, Journalism Studies and Communication Studies, etc.
- CALM is a one-year study programme consisting of 60 credits. Depending on their interests, students select eight 5-credit specialist modules. In addition they will do a 3-month work placement (20 credits).
- CALM-students complete a 3-month work placement (20 credits) with a language technology or translation company

The tuition fee for the entire programme amounts to 2.000 €. Students who want to take a few modules only will pay a tuition fee according to the number of credits. Application deadline is **31 May 2017**.
